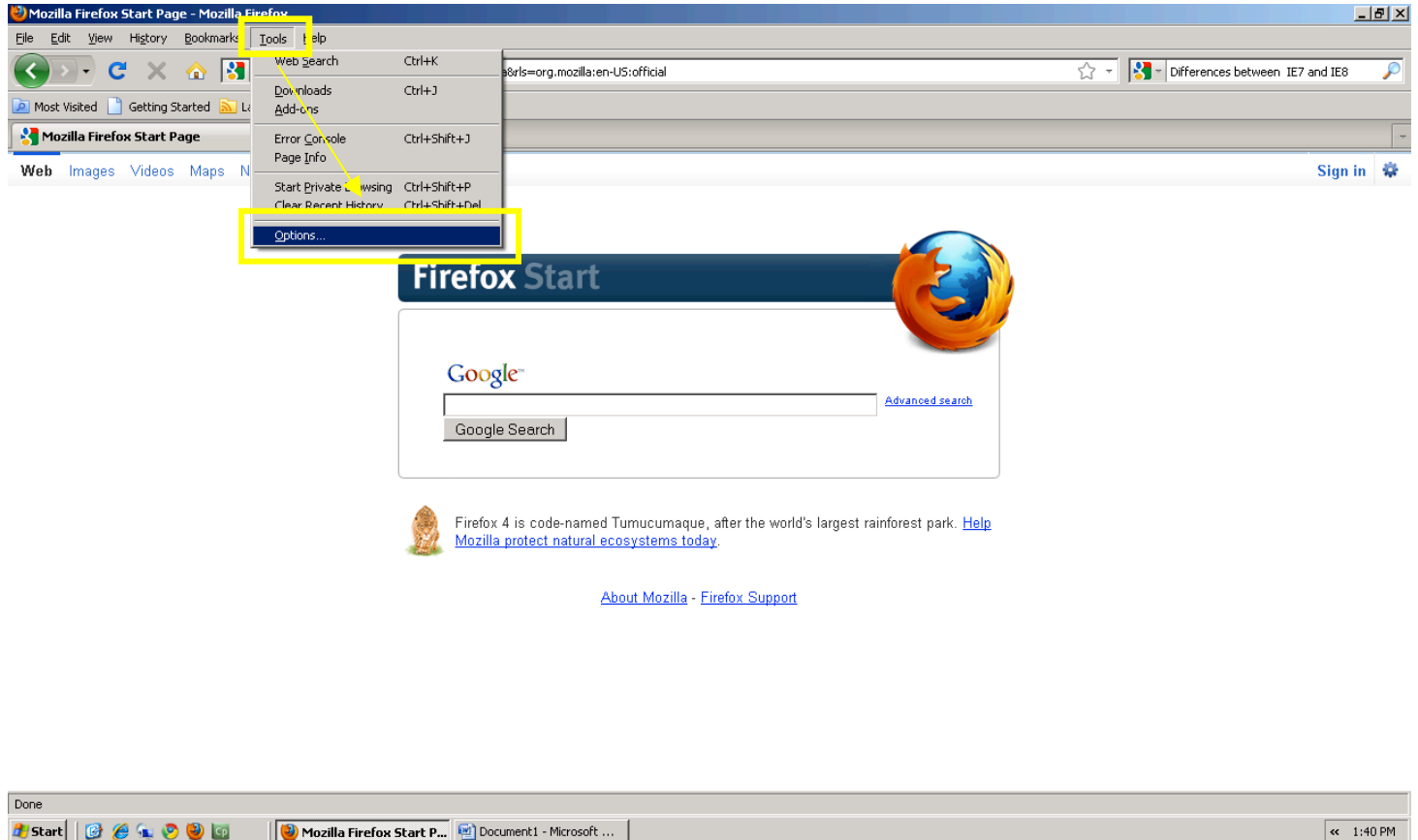
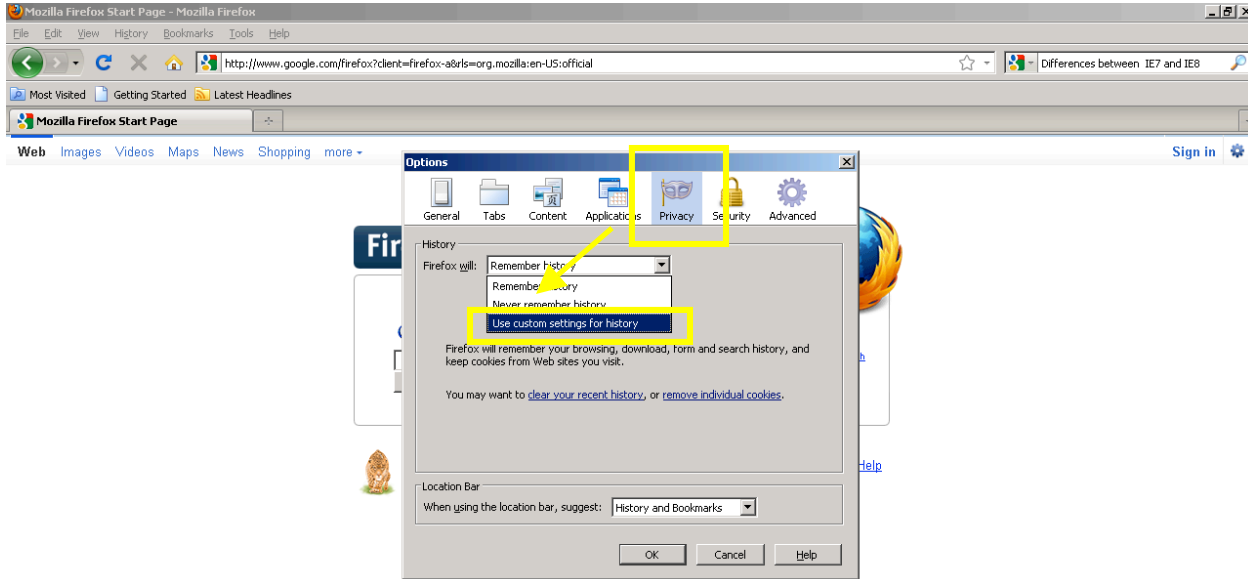


Enabling Cookies – PC – Mozilla Firefox

Step 1: Go to the Menu Bar and select the drop-down tab labeled **“Tools”**. At the bottom of the **“Tools”** tab, select the **“Options...”** tab.



Step 2: A new **“Options”** window will appear with the tabs **“General”** through **“Advanced”** present. Click on the **“Privacy”** tab (third from the left). At the top of the **“Privacy”** box, there will be a **“Firefox will:”** dropdown screen with the options, **“Remember history”**, **“Never remember history”**, and **“Use custom settings for history”**. Click the **“Use custom settings for history”** option.



Setting 3: Under the option for **“Use custom settings for history”**, a number of boxes will become available. Make sure the box labeled, **“Accept cookies from sites”** is checked. Click OK, and cookies are now enabled.
